If accepted, students will receive an invitation to Camp Orientation: Saturday, June 5. The total camp fee is \$75. A \$25 deposit must be included with the application and will be returned if not accepted.

The remainder to be paid at Orientation on June 5, 2017.

- I understand that if accepted to attend Camp Renaissance, my child is making a year-round commitment to participate in programs with the Greenville Renaissance Scholars.


